General Information

Two Great Opportunities

Get ahead! Courses for high school credit are offered each summer by Waubonsee Community College in cooperation with area school districts. A significant number of students take summer courses to “work ahead” and/or clear their schedule for electives.

Catch up! Most students, however, take summer courses for remedial and credit recovery purposes. Whatever the reason, students are required to work with their high school counselor to choose appropriate courses.

Courses are offered at the Sugar Grove Campus, Aurora Campus and Copley Campus, as well as extension sites. For complete course schedule information, see pages 5-6.

2010 High School Summer Schedule

Courses meet Mondays - Fridays, June 22 - July 28 (no classes Monday, July 5). See the course schedule for specific dates, times and locations.

Registration and Fees

Registration: March 1-June 15

Sorry - no registrations can be accepted after June 15.

Cost: \$165 per one-semester course

Some courses require an additional textbook fee as indicated on the course schedule. Students will receive their textbooks on the first day of class.

Full payment is due at the time of registration. No financial assistance or payment plan is available.

Registrations are accepted and processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Courses fill fast — students are encouraged to register as early as possible to ensure the best selection. Courses are subject to cancellation due to limited enrollment one week prior to program start date.

No refunds will be given after June 15.

The registration form and instructions can be found on pages 6-8. Please note that only complete and signed registration forms (along with full payment) can be accepted.

Transportation and Parking

Transportation is the responsibility of the student. Free parking is available at the Sugar Grove and Copley Campuses as well as extension sites. At the Aurora Campus, students may park at the Stolp Island garage at a discounted rate. The parking stub must be validated at the front desk of the Aurora Campus to obtain the discount.

No registrations can be accepted after June 15. Register early to secure your spot!

2010 High School Summer Program Policies

Important! Please read! We want to provide students with an optimum environment for learning and success. Therefore, the High School Summer Program has high expectations for student attendance, behavior and attitude — students who do not exhibit proper attendance, behavior or attitude, or who violate any program/college rules, are subject to removal from the program without a refund.

Parents and students are encouraged to review the attendance and behavior policies **before** committing to the High School Summer Program.

Attendance

Attendance is required. Students are expected to attend the duration of their course(s), including final exam days. For one-semester courses meeting June 22-July 28 (classes on p. 5), students are allowed two absences. For two-semester courses meeting June 22-July 9 or July 12-July 28 (classes on p. 6), students are allowed one absence per semester. An absence is defined as missing more than 25 percent of a class period or being late (tardy) to class more than three times. *Upon the third absence, students will be dropped (without refund) from the course.*

To promote a fair and successful experience for all students, no exceptions are made to the attendance policy. Please check for conflicts with vacations, camps, etc. before committing to the High School Summer Program.

Behavior

Each student is responsible for knowledge of, and compliance with, the Waubonsee Community College Code of Student Conduct. Copies of the conduct code will be distributed to students on the first day of the program.

Mature behavior is expected during breaks, as well as in the classroom. Students are discouraged from wearing specific clothing or displaying gestures that could be associated with gang affiliation; such displays will not be tolerated. Students are discouraged from being on campus when not in class.

All Waubonsee campuses and extension sites are drug, alcohol, smoke and gun-free areas. Possession of these items is strictly forbidden. In addition, no electronic devices (cell phones, iPods, etc.) or other disruptive items are allowed in the classroom. Food and drinks are allowed only in designated lounge areas and should not be taken into classrooms or hallways.

Failure to comply with rules, the Code of Student Conduct, or exhibition of threatening behavior may result in: behavioral tardies/absences, referral to the Student Conduct Board and Public Safety, suspension, arrest, or other disciplinary action.
